Volunteer applicants who best meet the Library's needs will be contacted and these positions will be awarded by June 25th. **IMPORTANT: All 2016 Student** Volunteers and their legal guardians must sign the Student Volunteer Agreement before they may begin helping at the library. Per the Mary E. Bartlett Library Volunteer Policy, "volunteers aged 14 or 15 must also provide **proof of age** to the Library and a **Youth Employment Certificate** issued by the minor's school. Volunteer services cannot begin until a photocopy of proof of age is on file at the Library. Volunteers aged 16 or 17 must also complete and submit the New Hampshire Department of Labor "Parental Permission" form and provide proof of age to the Library."
