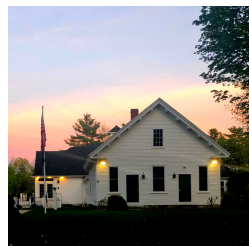

# DONATIONS

Many of you have been wondering when we will be able to take donations again. It has taken us some time to figure out the best way to handle this, given the precautions we are committed to using for the safety of our patrons and staff, but I'm happy to say we are ready to move forward with this service!

So, how will it work?

- Up to 5 books and/or DVD donations can be put in the book drop at any time.

What if I have more than 5 items?

- Call to schedule a drop-off appointment

What can I donate?

- We will accept hardcover and paperback books in good condition. Please check with us before bringing in other items like puzzles, games, and craft supplies due to space limitations.

What can't I bring in?

- Damaged books (e.g. broken bindings, missing pages, dirty, moldy, musty, or water damaged)
- Outdated materials (computer, medical, travel, etc. with information that changes quickly)
- Encyclopedias
- VHS movies
- Textbooks

When does this start?

- Monday, Feb. 1st, 2021

What happens to the things I donate?

- They are added to our collection, put into the Friends' book sale, used as prizes/giveaways, or recycled.
